BALLOTS





Phrag Potting Mix

- Aliflor 2 parts
- Grow Stone 2 parts
- Diatomite 1 part



Isopropyl Alcohol/409 Mixture

- 1 pint Isopropyl Alcohol
- 1 pint Formula 409 cleaner
- Pour both in 1 gallon jug
- Fill remainder of jug with water
- Mix thoroughly
- Pour into hand sprayer




