Tips, Tricks and Techniques

Ah, spring . . . Did you know?

"Genus: Cypripedium L. Lady's Slippers

There are approximately ten species of Lady's Slippers in the United States and Canada, but only one in Europe. Five species have been found in the Bruce-Grey area. The name of this genus is derived from Cypris, one of the names of Venus, the Greek goddess of love and beauty, and the Greek word *pedilon* meaning "shoe" in reference to the slipper-like lip which is the feature of this group. Hence the name Lady's Slipper for our most spectacular wild orchids. These are the orchids which attract the attention and admiration of all and this beauty often spells disaster. These orchids have been dug up, vandalized by photographers, picked in great bouquets, and generally abused by people who, in a vain attempt to capture and possess such loveliness, end by destroying it. In all species the column is declined over the opening of the lip with a fertile stamen on each side and a conspicuous staminode (sterile stamen) above which covers the tip of the style. Thus, insects attracted by the staminode and investigating the "slipper" pick up pollen from the fertile stamens."

Five species found in Bruce and Grey counties named in the Guide are:

Pink Moccasin Flower, *Cypripedium acaule* Aiton. Pink Moccasin Flower, Pink Lady's Slipper, Stemless Lady's Slipper.

Ram's Head Lady's Slipper, Cypripedium arietinnum R. Brown. Ram's Head Lady's Slipper.

Large Yellow Lady's Slipper, Variety: *Cypripedium calceolus* L. var. *pubescens* (Willd.) Correll. (*Cypripedium pubescens*) Large Yellow Lady's Slipper.

Small White Lady's Slipper, *Cypripedium cadidum* Muhl. Ex Willd. Small White Lady's Slipper.

Showy (Queen) Lady's Slipper. *Cypripedium reginae* Walter. Showy Lady's Slipper, Queen Lady's Slipper.



Responsibly sourced cypripediums can be acquired from vendors at this time of year. Some were seen at the London Orchid Show. More recently, **John Marcotte** offered some plants for sale and instructed how to grow them successfully in home gardens.
